Only State agencies and public authorities that have made payments will appear on the selection list within a certain time period.

2. Which agencies are public authorities and why don't all disbursements display for them?

You can tell which agencies are public authorities because their titles usually include "authority" or "corporation".

Many disbursements for public authorities don't display in State Agency Spending because they don't flow through the State Treasury and the Legislature rarely appropriates their operational expenses. That spending is considered 'off budget'.
